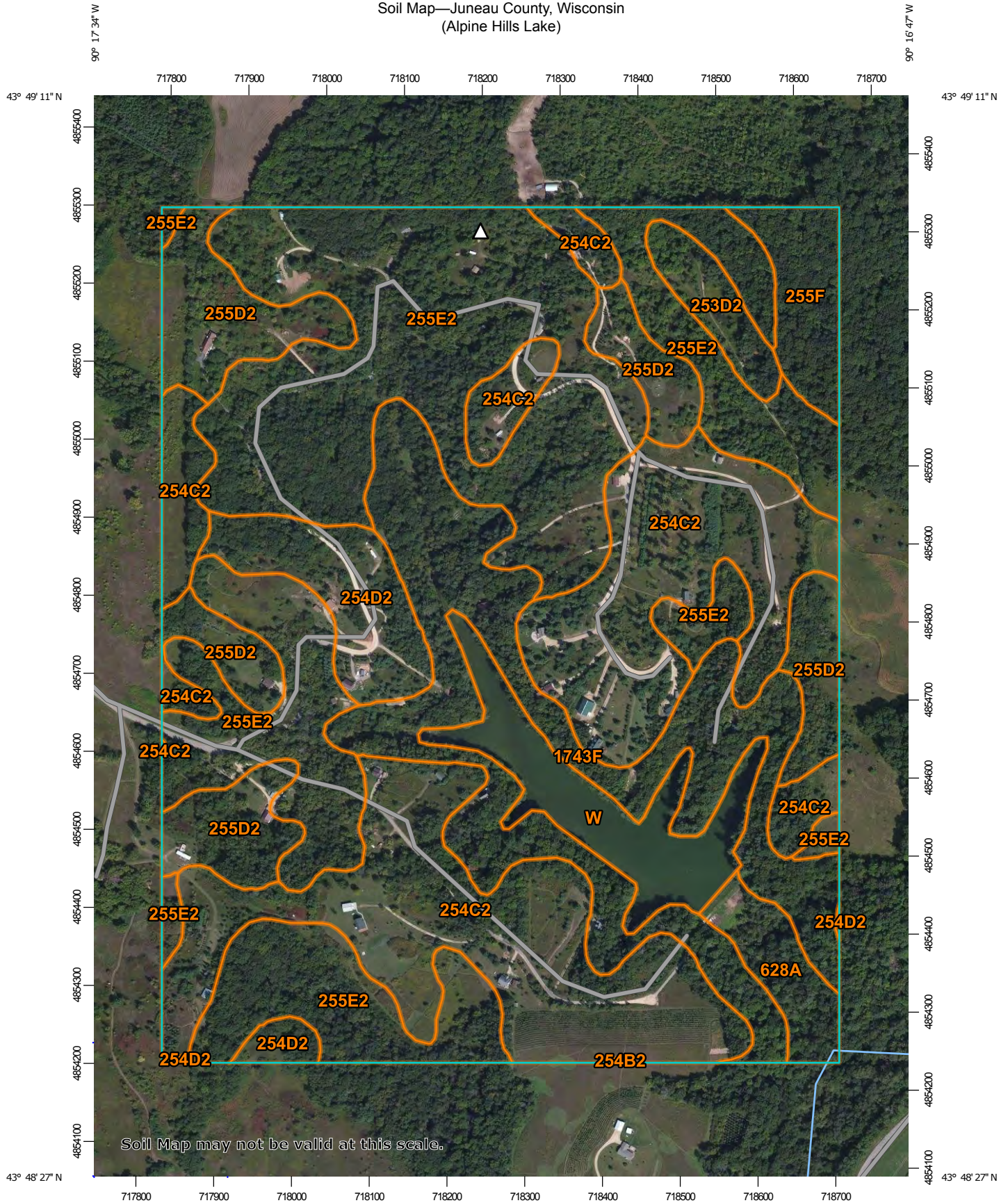
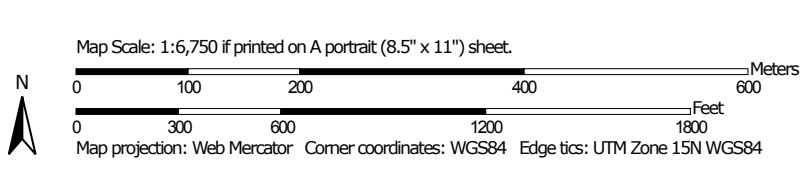


Soil Map—Juneau County, Wisconsin
