They are Fish Lake, Crooked Lake, Bohn Lake, Lyman Lake, Ueeck Lake, Marl Lake, Mill Pond, Lake Virginia and Hartford Lake. You might also try Schmudlach Creek class trout stream. Besides the County owned public land by Hartford Lake, there is Bohn Lake State Ice Age Trail and Bohn Lake State Natural area. More areas open to the public are the The Ice Age National Scenic Area Trail systems and Greenwood State Wildlife Refuge as well. Deerfield Township has a mix of large farmland acreage and wooded land. Waushara County Waushara County, Wisconsin is located between Adams and Waupaca in the central part of the state along Lake Poygan. It is known for its farming, Amish communities, boating, fishing, hunting, biking, hiking, arts, culture, golfing, rolling terrain, spring fed lakes, parks, public land, wildlife, bird watching, snowmobiling, skiing and ice skating.
